### **Citizens of Countries allowed to enter Greece**

Travelers from the countries below will be allowed to enter Greece, with **no quarantine obligation**.

European Union & Schengen Area countries, USA, UK, Israel, Serbia, UAE, New Zealand, Australia, South Korea, Thailand, Rwanda, Singapore, the Russian Federation, North Macedonia, Canada, Belarus, Bahrain, Qatar, China, Kuwait, Ukraine, and Saudi Arabia and Bosnia – Herzegovina, Montenegro.

### **Documents required for entry into Greece**

- 1- It is mandatory to fill out the **PLF** form on the government website <https://travel.gov.gr> until 23:59 hrs one day before arrival.
- 2- Passengers arriving from International flights, must hold **ONE** of the documents below:
  - have completed at least fourteen (14) days of vaccination for COVID-19 and present a vaccination certificate, in English, French, German, Spanish, Italian or Russian, issued by a public authority in accordance with the relevant legislation. The vaccination certificate includes the person's name, the type of vaccine administered and the number of doses.
  - Have a negative PCR test performed at least 72 hours prior to arrival in Greece.
  - Have a negative “rapid test” antigens performed at least 48 hours prior to arrival in Greece.
  - Have proof of recovery from COVID-19, valid from 2 months after PCR or positive antigen test for up to 6 months.

\* tests required for over 12 years old

### **Domestic travel**

For boarding ships and flights to Domestic destinations:

#### From the mainland - to islands:

- 1- (For Flights and Boats): Vaccination certificate is required (14 days after the last dose) **OR** a negative PCR test performed at least 72 hours before departure **OR** “rapid test” antigen performed at least 48 hours prior to the embarkation. Children up to 12 years old are not required to test. Children from 12-17 years old can perform a “self test” (available in pharmacy) with the completed document indicating the result (available at <https://self-testing.gov.gr/covid19-self-test-print.pdf> (Valid from July 5 2021)
- 2- (For Boats): Pre-shipment document with a questionnaire from the Maritime Company with contact information. Delivered together with the boat tickets to fill out or available to fill out at <https://sea.travel.gov.gr/#/>

Between islands (from one island to another): tickets and Pre-shipment document with a questionnaire from the Maritime Company with contact information. Delivered together with the boat tickets to fill out or available to fill out at <https://sea.travel.gov.gr/#/>

#### From the islands – to the Mainland:

- 1- (For Flights): ticket only
- 2- (For Boats) Document with questionnaire from Maritime Company with contact information. Delivered with boat tickets or available to fill out at <https://sea.travel.gov.gr/#/>

### **Inter Alpha Travel staff and Agents**

The entire Inter Alpha Travel staff is required to undergo a Covid-19 test each week and has proof of the test and result, in accordance with the security protocols adopted by the government.

Mandatory usage of face mask only indoors

### **Personal assistance with passengers**

Assistants who personally assist passengers upon their arrival, will meet passengers at the Hotel or inform them locally at ports or Airports.

They will only accompany customers together in the vehicles in special cases and when the number of people in the vehicle allows.

### **Curfew time**

No curfew hours

### **Use of masks**

Mandatory indoors only. Not required outdoors.

### **Archeological sites, open air museums - Open**

-1.5 meters of distance in between

-usage of face masks

\* we recommend the use of "whispers"

- Group tours for up to 15 people (we split into 2 groups if there are more than 15 people)

### **Museums - Open**

2 meters of distance in between

1 person for every 15m<sup>2</sup>

- Group tours up to 8 people (we split into 2 groups if there are more than 8 people)

- Mandatory use of mask for everyone

\* we recommend the use of "whispers"

### **Restaurants - Open**

- Mandatory use of mask for the staff

-6 people max per table

-Only outdoor seating

### **Bars – Open**

-Only outdoor seating

-Mandatory use of mask for the staff

### **Transport**

- buses 85% of capacity.

- use face masks in vehicles

- 85% of the capacity on ships with cabins and 80% without cabins

- 3 people in Taxi

- 4 people in Mini Vans
