Documents required for entry into Greece

- 1- **Travelers from the European Union (EU)** and Schengen countries, **USA, Canada, Australia** as well as the 35 non-EU countries* that have joined the EU COVID digital certification system, can enter the country with the **COVID-19 Vaccination certificate** after completing at least fourteen (14) days up to 9 months after vaccination for COVID-19 for basic vaccination or without time limit if the booster dose has been taken, or alternatively:
 - Have a negative PCR test performed at least 72 hours prior to arrival in Greece.
 - Have a negative Rapid Antigen test performed at least 24 hours prior to arrival in Greece.
 - Have proof of recovery from COVID-19, valid from 14 days to 6 months (180 days) after PCR or positive antigen test.

* 35 countries that have joined the digital certification system: Albania, Andorra, Armenia, Benin, Cabo Verde, El Salvador, Faroe Islands, Georgia, Israel, Iceland, Jordan, Lebanon, Liechtenstein, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Morocco, New Zealand, North Macedonia, Norway, Panama, San Marino, Serbia, Singapore, Switzerland, “Chinese Taipei (not recognized as a State by Greece)”, Thailand, Tunisia, Togo, Turkey, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, Uruguay, The Vatican, is permitted by showing the EU Digital COVID Certificate, which contains information about one of the following:

- 2- **Travelers from all countries**, except those mentioned above, are allowed to enter if:
 - Have a negative PCR test performed at least 72 hours prior to arrival in Greece **or**
 - Have a negative Rapid Antigen test performed at least 24 hours prior to arrival in Greece.

* tests required for over 5 years old

Domestic travel

For boarding ships and flights to Domestic destinations:

All Domestic destinations:

(For Flights and Boats): Vaccination certificate is required (14 days after the last dose). All adults who have been vaccinated and have passed the period of 7 months for 2-dose vaccine or 3 months for 1-dose vaccines, to be considered valid, need to have the booster dose taken.

OR a negative PCR test performed at least 72 hours before departure

OR “rapid test” antigen performed at least 48 hours prior to the embarkation.

OR have a proof of recovery from COVID-19, valid from 14 days to 90 days after PCR or positive antigen test.

The entire staff is vaccinated, in accordance with the security protocols adopted by the government.

Mandatory usage of face mask only indoors

Personal assistance with passengers

Assistants who personally assist passengers upon their arrival, will meet passengers at the Hotel or inform them locally at ports or Airports. They will only accompany customers together in the vehicles when the maximum capacity of the protocol in the vehicle allows.

Curfew time

No curfew hours

Use of masks

Mandatory indoors only. Not required outdoors.

Archeological sites, open air museums

- 1.5 meters of distance in between
- usage of face masks
- * we recommend the use of "whispers"
- Group tours for up to 40 people
- Necessary to have a vaccination certificate **OR** PCR test 72 hours before **OR** rapid test 48hrs before required

Museums, indoors

- 2 meters of distance in between
- 1 person for every 15m²
- Group tours 20 – 30 people according to each museum and depending on their size
- Mandatory use of mask for everyone
- * we recommend the use of "whispers"
- Necessary to have a vaccination certificate or recovery certificate. Children from 4-17 can have a self-test.

Restaurants

- Mandatory use of mask for the staff

Seats on outdoors

- Necessary to have a vaccination certificate **OR** PCR test 72 hours before **OR** rapid test 48hrs before required
- 6 people max per table

Indoor seats

- Necessary to have a vaccination certificate or recovery certificate
- 6 people max per table

Bars – Open

- Mandatory use of mask for the staff
- outdoor seats with PCR or Antigen Test or Vaccination certificate
- indoor seats with Vaccination certificate or recovery certificate only

Transport

- buses 100% of capacity.
- use face masks in vehicles (FFP2 or N95 or double mask)
- 100% of the capacity on ships
- 3 people in Taxi
- 8 people in Mini Vans
